HOW?

- If you are 18 or older and a citizen, you're eligible to vote!
- Get registered by visiting votetexas.org or your local Tax Assessors office.

Note*: you cannot register online in Texas, you must send in something via mail or register in person with a Volunteer Deputy Voter Registrar.

WHY?

- Local elections come down to just a handful of votes.
- Your voice can make a big difference when it comes to holding elected officials accountable and creating local change.

WHEN?

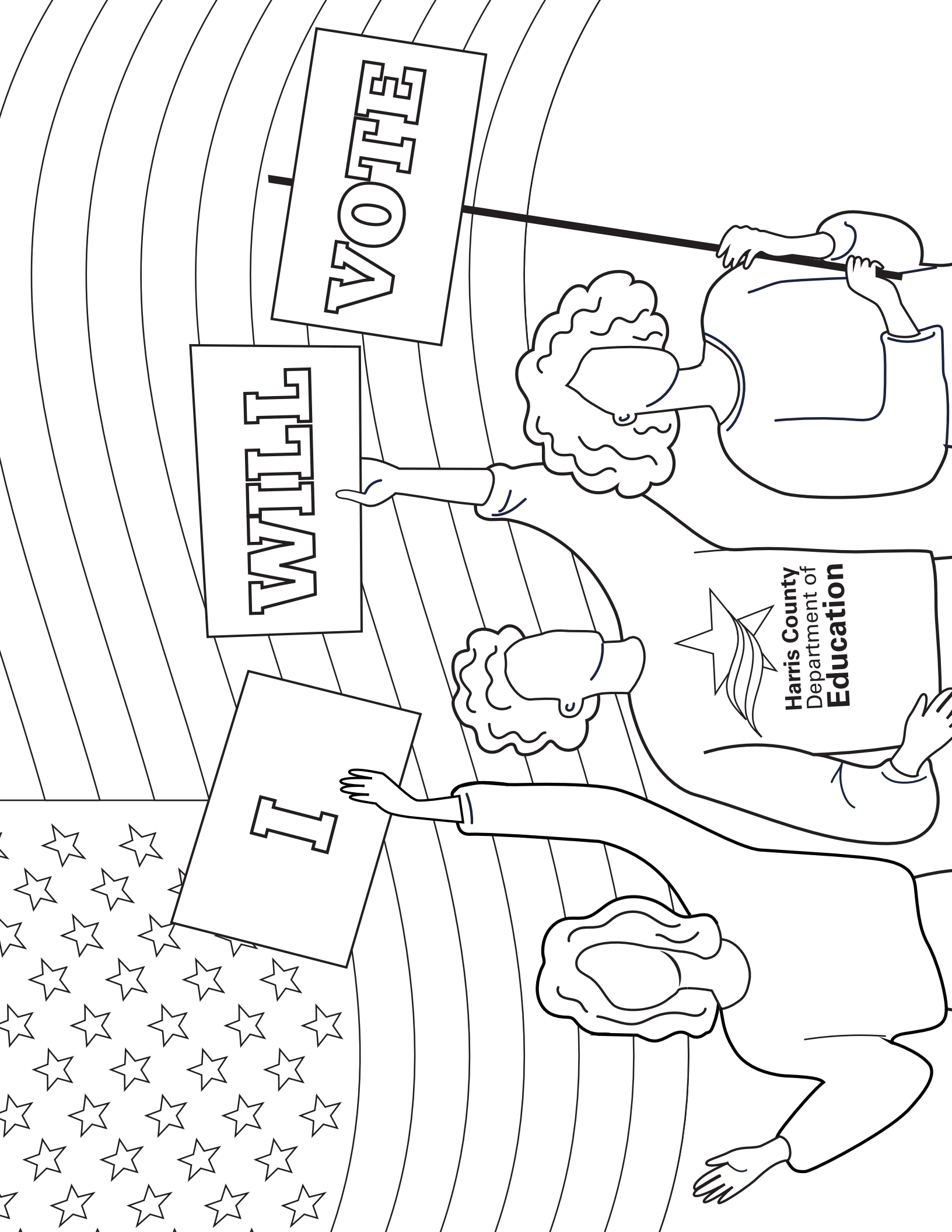
- Elections are held every year, almost always on the **first Tuesday in November**. Don't forget the local ones!
 - November 5th, 2024
 - November 4th, 2025
 - November 3rd, 2026
- Primaries are held in the spring to narrow down candidates from each party.
- Runoffs are held in Texas after each election for each race where a candidate does not receive 50% of the vote.

WHERE?
