Education is critical for breaking the poverty cycle and its importance is reflected within the American economic structure. **One in three adults in Harris County are considered low** functionally illiterate. They are unable to manage daily activities and employment tasks that require reading skills beyond a basic level in any language. HCDE Adult Education provides access to free adult literacy and workforce programs which enable participants to learn skills that influence their **health** and **well-being** and support their **functionality** in society as a **thriving adult**. Without access to affordable adult education programming many individuals and families are subject to becoming a statistic.


