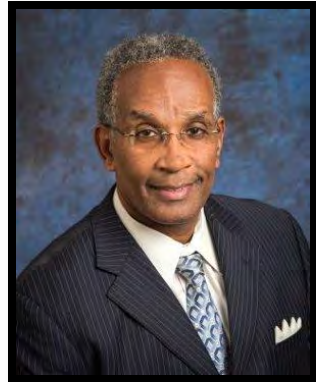

Sgt. Jeff McGowen retired from the Harris County Sheriff's Office after serving more than 28 years. He was temporarily discharged from the United States Army Reserves as a veteran of Desert Storm and is the past president of the Texas Crime Prevention Association. He joined the Adams ISD Police Department in July 2007 and is currently assigned as the evening shift patrol supervisor. McGowen is an adjunct instructor specializing in Active Shooter Situations CRASE training, intelligence, Threat Assessment training, Child Passenger Safety training and TCCOLE, Crime Prevention Proficiency Certification. He has also obtained licenses for master peace officer, master police proficiency, TCCOLE instructor, Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design and certified crime prevention specialist.

OBJECTIVE:
To educate school administrators, faculty, staff and first responders on the proper response to active shooters on campus. While the likelihood of an incident occurring on a campus is still rare, training, preparation and mitigation efforts are at the forefront of prevention. "If we cannot imagine someone doing harm to us, we cannot begin to stop it."

IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

STUDENTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced
Do business as usual

ADULTS

Close and lock the door
Account for students and adults
Do business as usual



SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors.

STUDENTS

Return to inside of building
Do business as usual

ADULTS

Bring everyone indoors
Lock outside doors
Increase situational awareness
Account for students and adults
Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

STUDENTS

Move away from sight
Maintain silence
Do not open the door

ADULTS

Recover students from hallway if possible
Lock the classroom door
Turn out the lights
Move away from sight
Maintain silence
Do not open the door
Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified)

STUDENTS

Leave stuff behind if required to if possible, bring your phone
Follow instructions

ADULTS

Lead students to Evacuation location
Account for students and adults
Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults



SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy.

STUDENTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard

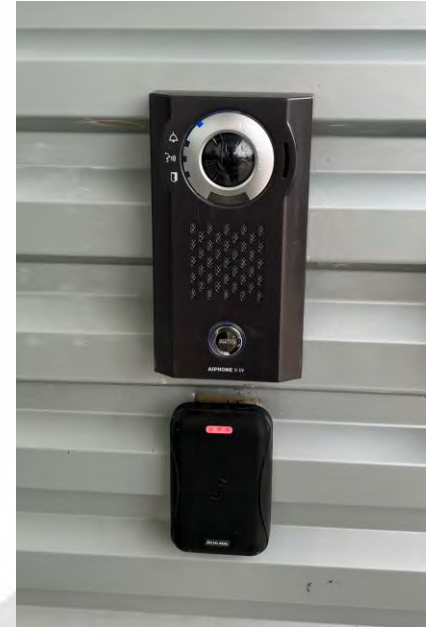

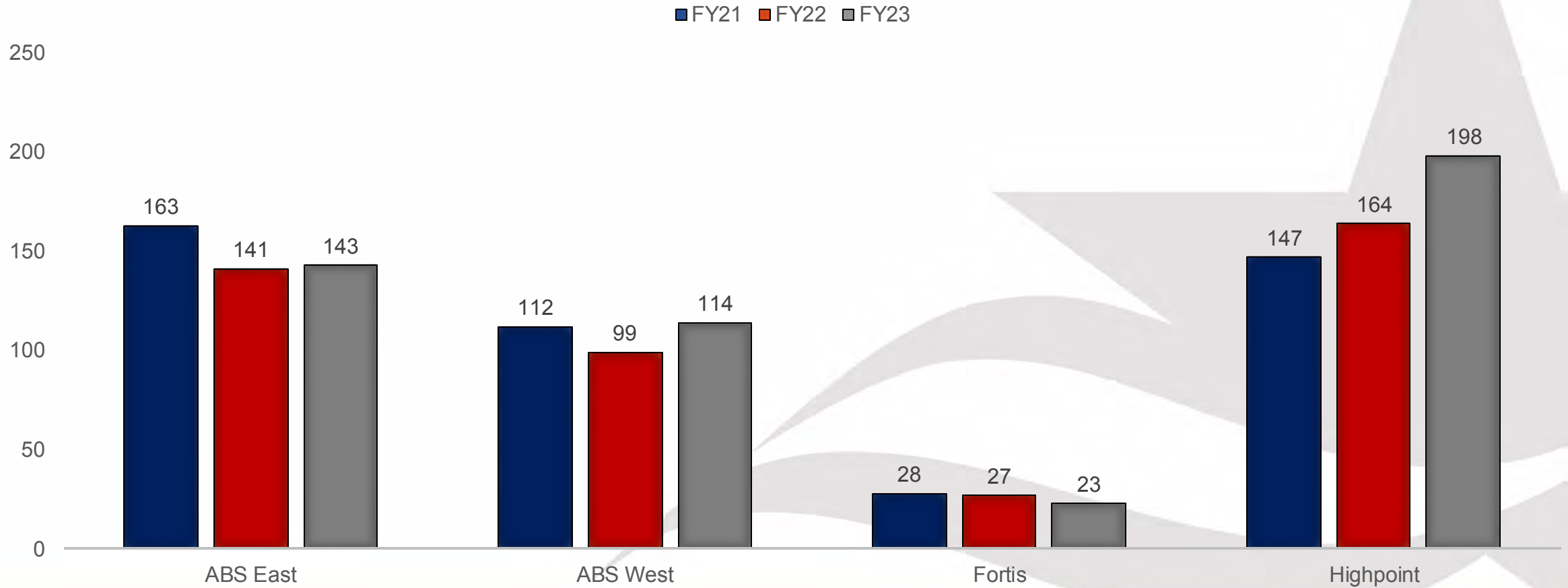

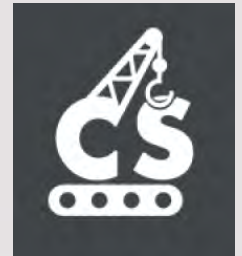
